Policy 6159 Instruction

SPECIAL EDUCATION / PLANNING AND PLACEMENT TEAMS

LEARN adheres to all State and Federal laws and regulations relating to special education

and Section 504 programs and services.

For students attending LEARN-supported schools and requiring special education services the sending school district must hold the Planning and Placement Team (PPT) meetings, and

must invite representatives from the LEARN-supported school to participate.

For students who attend LEARN-supported schools on a full-time basis, such schools shall be responsible for ensuring that the students receive the services mandated by their

Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) or Section 504 Plans, whether such services are

provided by the LEARN-supported school or by the sending school district.

Sending school districts must pay LEARN's magnet schools for students requiring special education or having a Section 504 Plan, as provided in Section 10-264l(h) of the Connecticut

General Statutes.

LEARN magnet schools are responsible for providing early intervention services potentially

leading to a referral for special education evaluation.
