#### 3. Governors' LEAP Program

Learner Engagement and Attendance Program is funded out of Governor Lamont's office. The RESC Alliance has been tasked with supporting 15 districts across the state with the highest numbers of disengaged students. The goals of the program are to immediately bring students back to school, support a bridge programs for students over the summer, as well as create a sense of belonging as students enter school in the Fall. LEARN will be partner with Norwich and New London on this project.

## 4. ESSER Funding Update

Kate Ericson updated the Executive Committee on LEARN's process of spending their 1.4 million dollar amount of federal funding.

#### 5. Thoughtexchange—Business Model

LEARN is starting to generate customers for the Thoughtexchange tool. Kate Ericson informed the Executive Committee that two districts have purchased the product from LEARN, to date.

#### 6. Hatchetts Hill updates

Kate Ericson communicated to the Executive Committee that another theft of a catalytic converter had taken place on LEARN property. A chain link fence, high resolution cameras, and additional cameras will be installed in an effort to stop the thefts.
